Master Class Offsite | Master's Program Onboarding Workshop (Coconat Community Work in Nature)

All new Master students classes will spend three days together at <u>Coconat</u> with the program and studio directors, getting to know each other, working, cooking, eating, and exploring the topics through workshop formats.

The accommodation costs in shared rooms (2-4 people/per room) and the workspaces at Coconat are financed by the university. You only have to pay for meals. The costs for three days are a maximum of €72 per person; This includes a single hot meal (€16) on the evening of arrival, full board (3 meals) on October 16 (€44), and breakfast on the last day (€12). Individual meals can be deselected or prepared in the kitchen for a usage fee. Tea, coffee, and snacks are available free of charge. We will coordinate room assignments and meal requests on October 2.
